Luggage/Instrument Check-In Dec 27

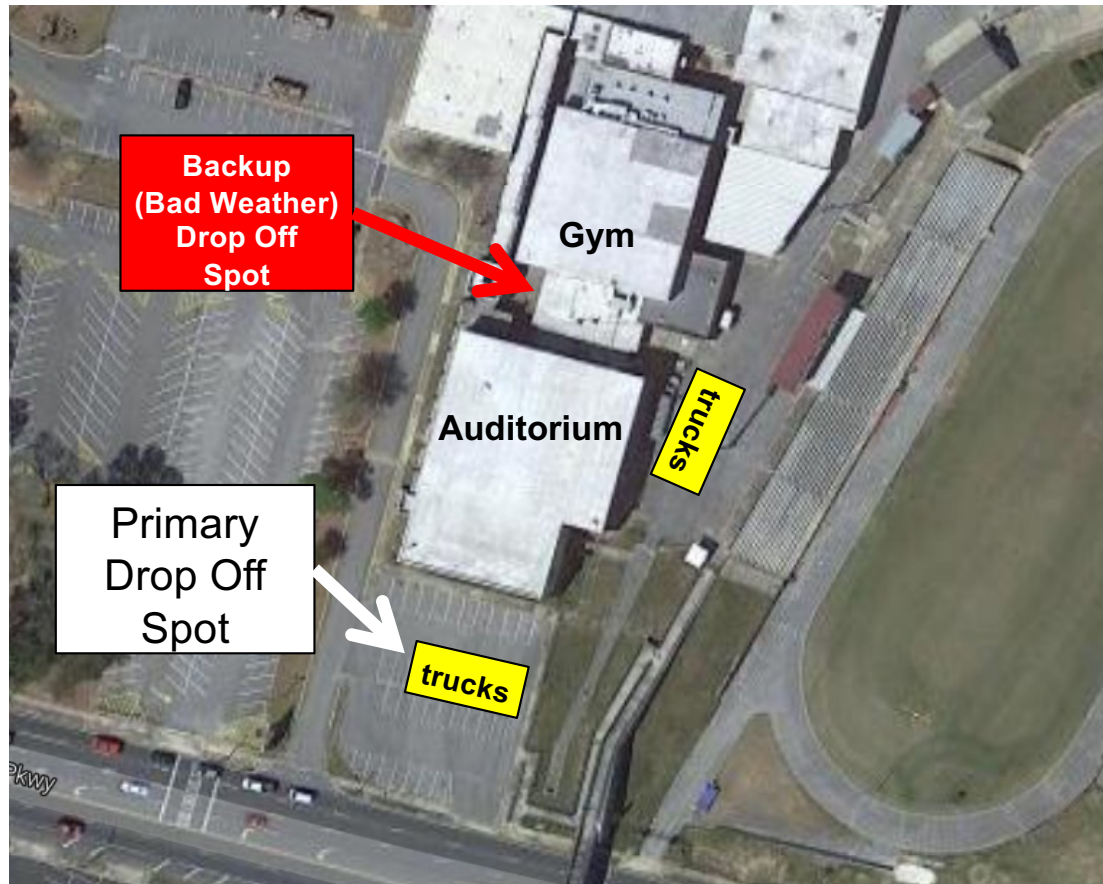
- Mandatory for all travelers who plan to bring luggage with them
- Schedule
 - 2-3pm: Tubas/Drums
 - 3-4pm: All Brass
 - 4-5pm: Woodwinds
 - 5-6pm: Colorguard/Majorettes, others
- Restrictions/Requirements
 - **1 checked bag per person, not to exceed 50 lbs**
 - **Must have proper ID**
 - Turn in Medicine at this time
 - F&F and Air-Only travellers can check bags for minors
 - TSA rules apply, assume bag will be opened and x-rayed
 - All students must be present to check bag

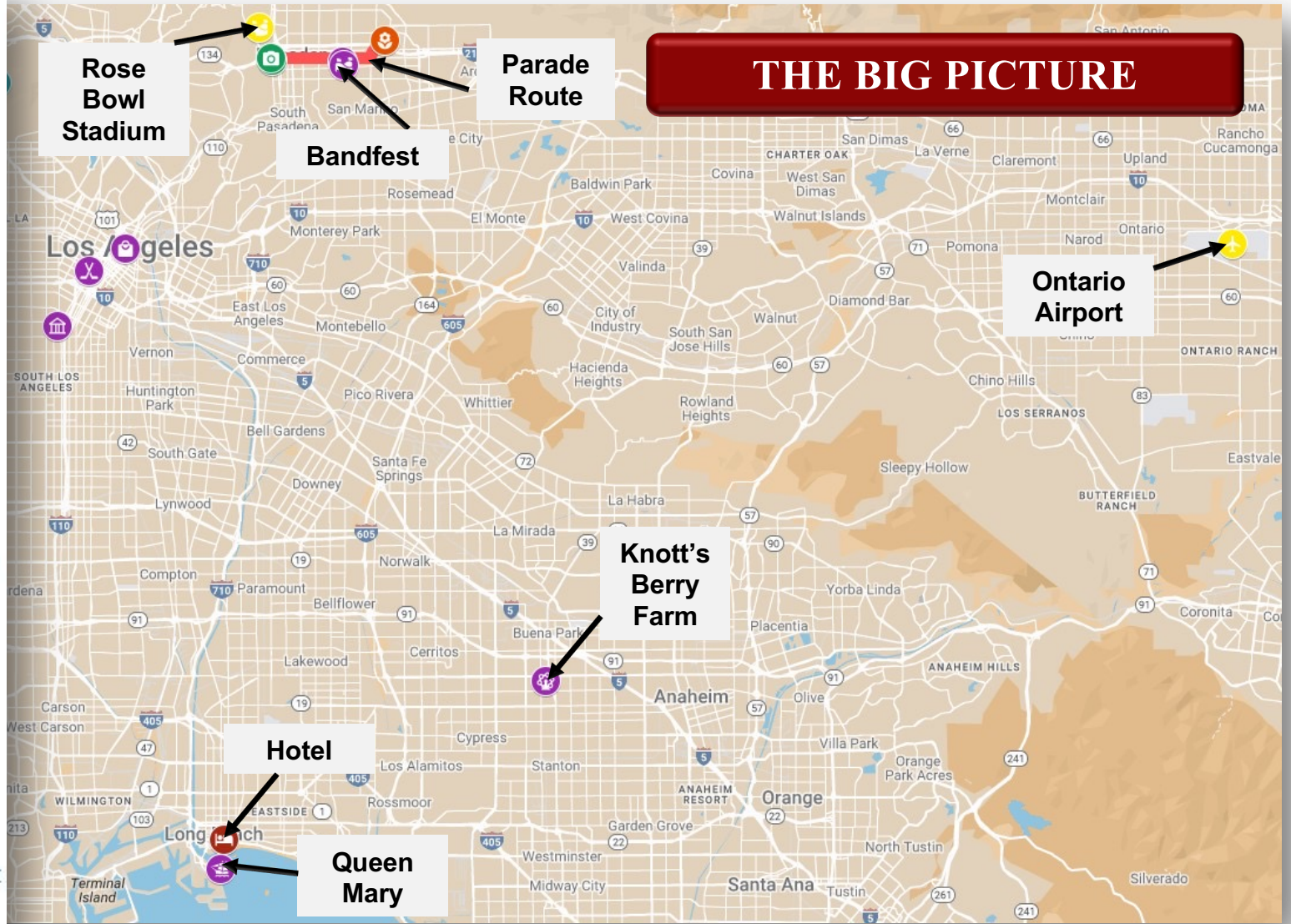

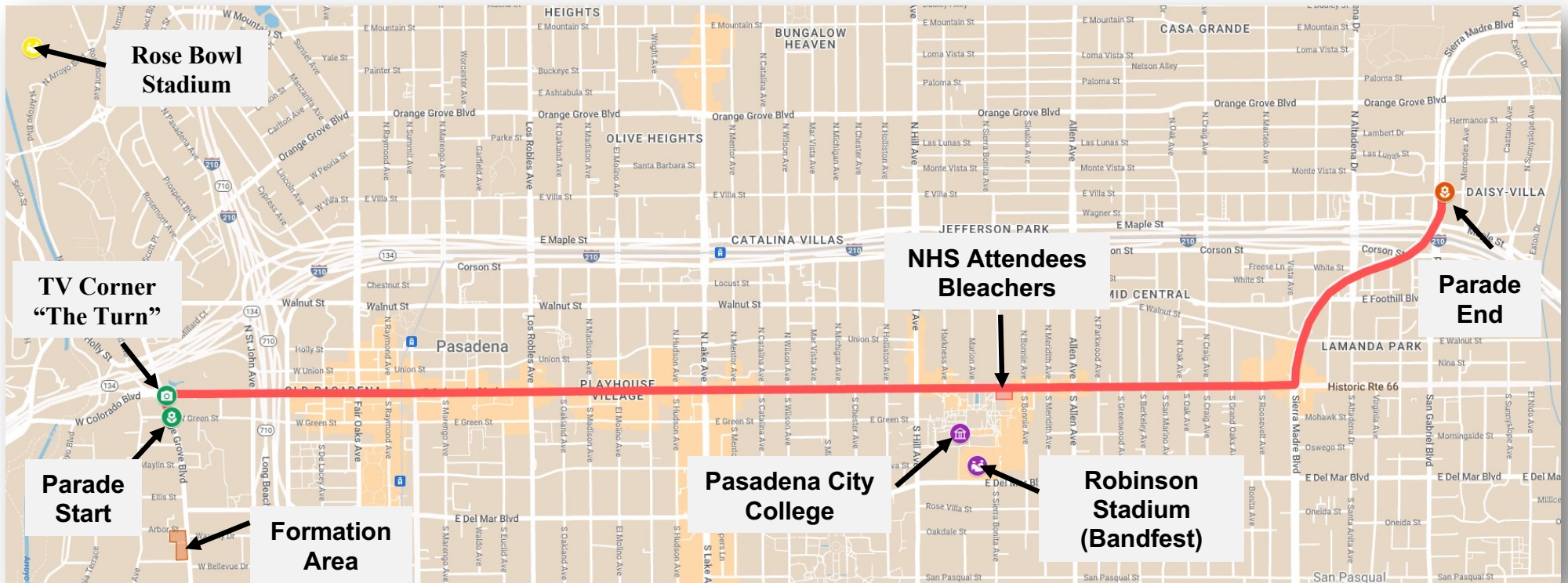

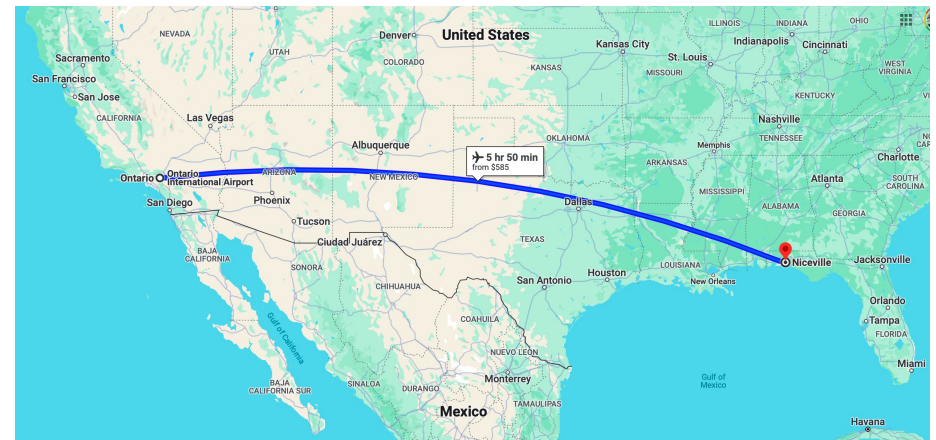

Chaperones

What to Pack in Suitcase?

“50 lb limit”

What to Pack in Suitcase?	
2-5 pairs jeans or khakis or pants NO HOLES, No sagging	2 additional T-shirts—see Student Attire handout
Band Hoodie	2 pairs leggings, sweats, gym shorts or PJs for HOTEL OR NIGHT ONLY
Undergarments, socks for 6 days	Extra pair of tennis shoes
Refillable water bottle if desired	Bring your own Band Aids and Kleenex
Toiletries/personal hygiene items	Moisturizer for dry skin
Toiletries and personal hygiene items – deodorant, tooth brush, toothpaste, feminine products, saline drops, contact solution and case, shampoo/conditioner etc. Spare contacts	
Boys: Dress pants, tie, collared long sleeve shirt, belt, dress shoes	
Girls: Dress (NHS dress code appropriate), or blouse and skirt/slacks, dress shoes (No mini skirts or bodycon)	

Do not lock suitcase!

Epi-pens and Inhalers must be placed in Clear Quart-sized Zip Lock Bag Please talk to Lonnie Hodges about this if you are in need of taking this kind of medicine		
Breakfast and Snacks for departure day–snack and beverages for auditorium – DO NOT BRING DRINKS TO AIRPORT OR ON BUS		
All liquids must be less than 3 oz, and all fit in 1 quart sized Ziploc bag		





What Not to Pack

- **NO**

- Expensive electronic devices
- Non-handheld video game systems (Play Stations, X Boxes, Oculus etc).
- Docks or HDMI cables for Nintendo Switch
- No Alcohol, vapes, drugs, or tobacco. ZERO TOLERANCE
- Principal Mareello and 2 Niceville Police Officers will be travelling with us





Student Attire Guidelines

- All clothing must be school approved as outlined in the student handbook
- No tank-tops, shorts or flip-flops of any kind outside of hotel
- All clothing must fit in 1 suitcase; not to exceed 50# limit
- Do not pack items that are too revealing: low cut necklines or skirts that are too short - no mini-skirts!

Travel Policies and Procedures

- Parents and students must read Trip Policies, Rules & Regulations posted on the website
 - Understand the expectations for behavior
- Understand the consequences of poor student choices
 - May be under supervision of a chaperone for remainder of trip
 - May be referred to principal onsite
 - May be held out of parade at Director's discretion
 - May be sent home at students' expense



Travel Policies and Procedures

- No alcohol, vapes, tobacco or drugs allowed
- Do not leave room after “lights-out” time
- No students of opposite sex allowed in other rooms/floors
- Report at designated time for all events
- Wear designated attire of the day
- Stay with room group when transitioning locations
- Report back at assigned time at parks & events
- Moving from place to place in room groups
- Travel in groups of 3 as a minimum with at least 1 cellphone
- Listen to your chaperones
- Manage your money
- No use of hotel pool



Travel Policies and Procedures

- Cell phone usage and guidelines
 - **NEVER PERMITTED IN UNIFORM**
 - Permitted during non-curfew hours or organized activity
 - Chaperone cell phone numbers provided in lanyard
 - Students responsible to charge phones every night
 - Limit phone use during day to maintain charge
 - All students groups must have at least one cell phone with sufficient charge
 - Carry power bank to recharge during day
- May be confiscated if rules not followed





Travel Policies and Procedures

- Sick students will only return or stay in hotel for certain medical conditions such as fever or vomiting
- Students can check out of the trip before or after the Queen Mary
 - Once checked out, no longer on the trip
 - **Required notarized form due tonight**
 - Pickup at hotel lobby between 3:30 and 4:30 pm or 11-11:30 pm
 - Must call student's chaperone at least 30 minutes before pickup at above times and let them know you are on the way.

All meals (except for F&F at the Queen Mary) and meetings are private and guests will not be allowed



Travel Policies and Procedures

- Two Niceville police officers are travelling with the band with the explicit purpose of providing additional security at the hotel from lights out until wakeup call
 - Monitor halls at night
 - Prevent unauthorized personnel from entering NHS areas
- The policemen will also attend some of the events during the day

Hotel

- Room Captains
- Room Keys distributed to room captains
 - Keep key with you at all times
 - Put key in lanyard
- Only use designated elevators, not stairs (unless emergency in the hotel)
- Do not call front desk; call chaperone for towels, etc.
- Do not order movies or room service
- Do not order food to be delivered



Hotel

- 4 in one room can be challenging
- Be respectful of your other roommates
 - Organize belongings- keep room neat and orderly
 - Clean off beds so staff can make beds and clean
 - Lights out means lights out; no cell phones, no TV and go to sleep – do not leave room after lights out
- Everyone must shower at least once a day - **NO EXCEPTIONS**
 - Stagger option: 2-morning, 2-evening
 - Breakfast Stagger: 2-Breakfast; 2-rotate shower
 - Do not leave toiletry bag in bathroom due to lack of space



Meals

- Breakfast
 - Please eat to maintain energy and health - plenty of hot and cold options
- Lunch
 - In-and-Out Burger at Band Fest and after parade (included)
 - Plenty options on the day students purchase lunch at the Farmer's Market, Grand Central Market and Knott's Berry Farm (\$15-\$25 per meal on own)
- Dinner:
 - Buffet on way to hotel on travel day
 - Box dinner at Float decorating
 - Dinner at LA Kings game
 - Dinner at Knott's Berry Farm - fried chicken
 - Blast off Dinner Dance on the Queen Mary with the Friends and Family: plated



Meals

- Special dietary needs being worked on by GMT
 - In-N-Out has a dedicated food truck to prepare food for students with food allergies
 - Please self advocate/Identify yourself to your chaperone and your servers
 - Tonight is the last night to let us know if you have any dietary needs



Travel Tips

- You are not in Niceville—think safety
 - Gentlemen: Carry wallet in front pocket
 - Ladies: Keep purse straps over opposite shoulder
 - Consider belt/crossbody bag
 - Be cautious when opening wallet
 - Keep baGS closed and with you at all times
- Restrooms:
 - Go before we leave hotel
 - Go when possible: lunch, dinner, park, etc.



Tips to stay healthy

- Each day is very long with lots of walking & excitement
 - Stay hydrated with water not sodas
 - Eat at every meal—tell chaperones if there is a problem
 - Use jackets when it is cold outside
 - Get as much sleep as possible
- Wash hands and/or use sanitizer frequently
- Do not consume energy drinks
- Limit the amount of Starbucks or caffeinated drinks



Continue to Condition

- The students will march 6 miles in 2.5 hours!
- There will be no bathroom break
- Walk every day from now until departure
- You can not cram for this exam
- Stay hydrated and get rest

School Board Policy for Administering Medication to Students by School Personnel

- 1. Any medication, either prescription or nonprescription, to be administered to a student on school premises or at school functions (including field trips) must be brought to the school by the parent/guardian/authorized adult representative for retention and administering. No student will be allowed to have medication, prescription or nonprescription with the exception of an enzyme, EpiPen, insulin pen, or an asthma inhaler, in his/her possession on school premises, on a school bus, or at a school function. Enzymes, EpiPens, insulin pens, or asthma inhalers will be permitted to be carried with parental permission and physician's authorization.
2. Medication brought to school must be in the original prescription container, properly labeled with the child's name, doctor, name of medication, route, dosage, time to be administered, directions, and expiration date. A "Dispersion of Medication Form" must be completed for each medication and a method of disposal of any unused or expired medication designated. The medication must be counted jointly by the parent/guardian and a school clinic staff member. The parent/guardian and school clinic staff member must both sign the "Registry of Medication Form" for the initial medication drop off and each time additional medication is brought to the school. Any medication that is unused must be picked up within one week of the ending date noted or at the end of the school day on the last day of school. All unused medications left after these dates will be discarded by the school clinic staff.
3. Parents are encouraged to request prescriptions for medications which limit administration during school hours. First morning doses should be given at home with only mid-day doses administered by a school staff member.
4. Medication(s) will not be provided by the school.
5. The student will be accountable for appropriate use of medications/equipment in his/her possession. In the event of misuse of supplies or equipment, the students may be subject to disciplinary action.
